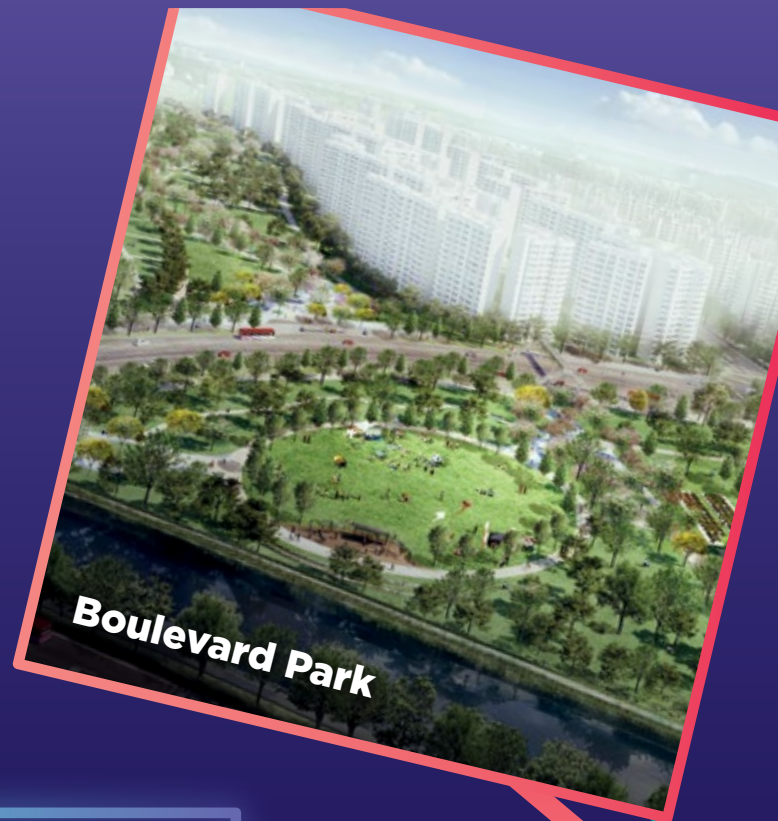

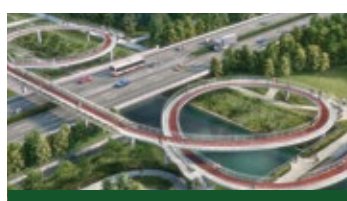

We are proud to present to you highlights of completed (2015- 2019) and future projects (2020 - 2024) in Tampines. The aim is to rejuvenate familiar places and create the capacity to meet future needs. In the next five years, residents can expect forward-looking projects that will improve vibrancy for us to lead an active lifestyle. We will have better connectivity and more inclusive amenities.

Because of COVID-19, I started the support group Sew Love SG to gather good-hearted volunteers to produce masks for our migrant workers and children. With the Tampines Supports SG Clean campaign, we were the first town to have all coffee shops fully certified SG Clean in March this year. I am confident that this will help boost public confidence about the cleanliness of our shared spaces.

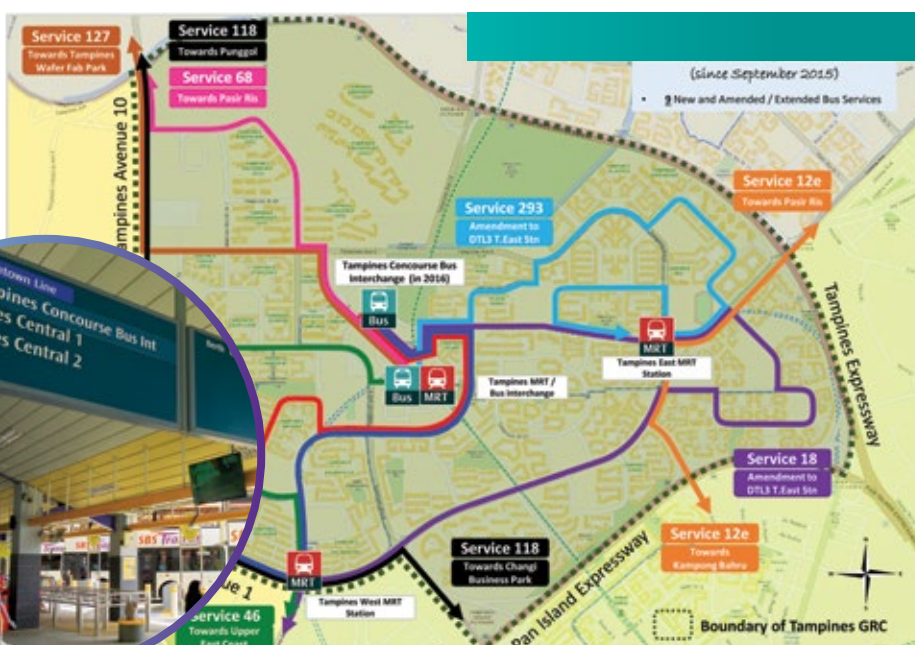

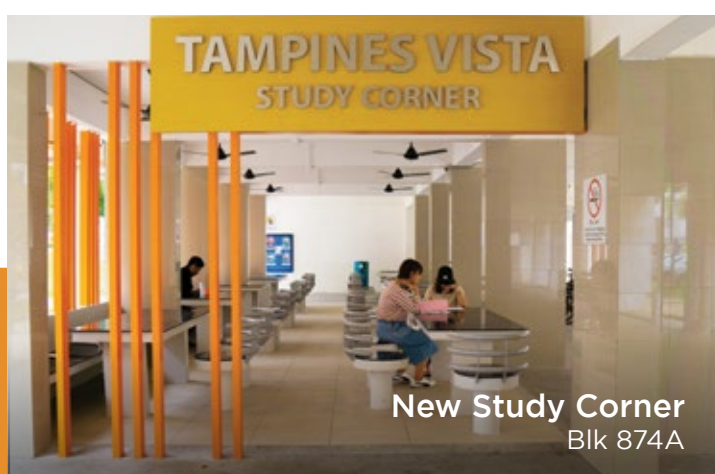
## BUILDING A BETTER HOME

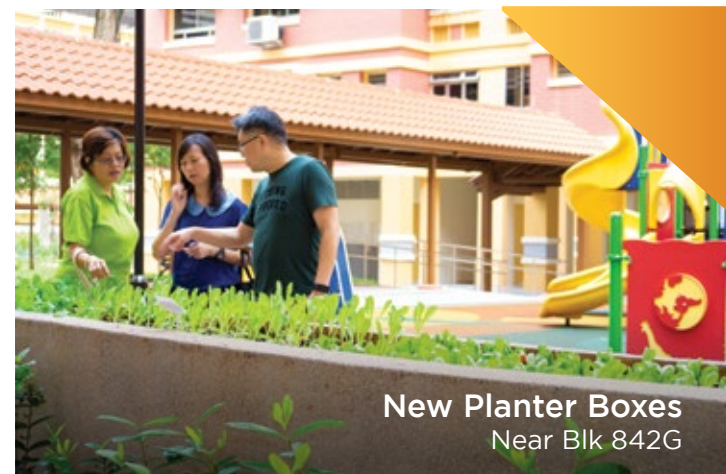

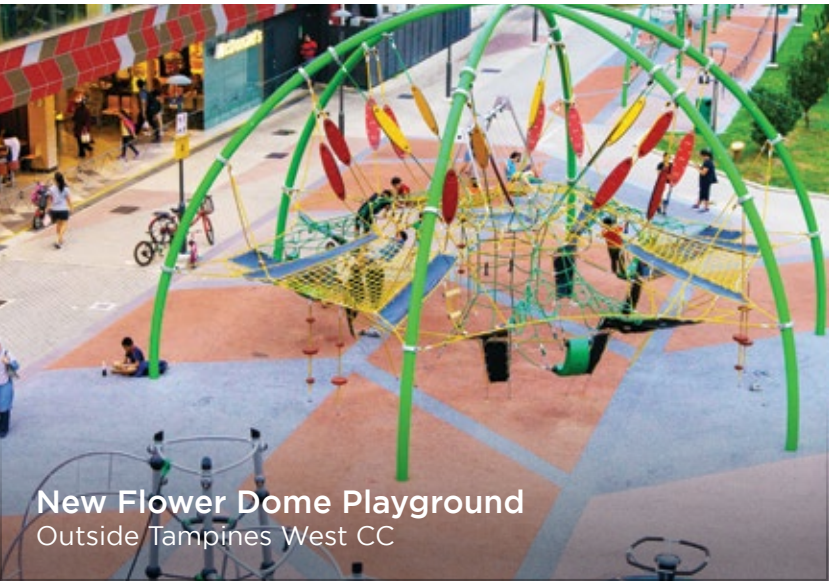

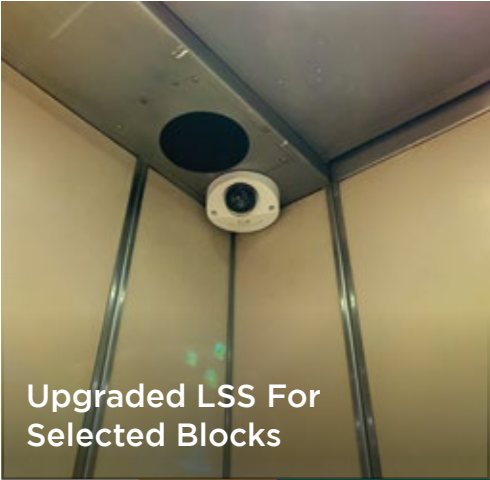

# ACTIVE THOROUGHFARE BRINGS FAMILIES TOGETHER

The Large Scale Town Wide project under the MRT viaduct enhances the park connector stretching from Tampines Town Centre to PIE Expressway. The viaduct serves as a popular thoroughfare connecting many residential areas to the Tampines MRT Station. This project will enhance the linear park with landscape features like new gardens, playgrounds and mazes.

### BIKE MAZE

Here, children can pedal on the colourful cycling path, facing obstacles such as humps, zigzag columns and quirky luminous frames. The Bike Maze brings out the fun and excitement of being a young cyclist.

### MOUNDS PLAYGROUND

The Mounds Playground has trampolines for you to jump on to reach the sky, tunnels to burrow into, various swings for toddlers, groups, and even parents who want to swing with their children.



### COMMUNITY PLAZA

The Community Plaza marks the entrance of the development. It consists of landmark signage and a shaded seating area for meet-ups.

### THE GARDEN

Next, you will journey into the gardens. Nestled amongst colourful flowers, are seats where you can rest while appreciating and admiring the beauty of nature.

### THE LAWN

Journeying on, you will reach the new lawn, accented with decorative screens, greenery and benches for resting. It's the perfect tranquil spot to appreciate the lush planting surroundings.





## ADVENTURE FITNESS CORNER

The last pit stop in this linear park is the Adventure Fitness Corner. It is equipped with a children's fitness corner and a sloping adventure play area.

## UNDER THE TREE

New family swings are placed under the shade of existing large trees for park-goers to take a breather and appreciate the spinning wind sculptures amongst blooming flowers.



## THE STREAM

A boardwalk with new decking sits beside the new stream, while the bioswale acts as a natural filter for rainwater, beautifying the surrounding landscape and promoting biodiversity.



## THE CASCADE

This rain garden fills up on rainy days, drains rainwater runoff using natural filters and rejuvenates the surrounding landscape by enriching biodiversity.

# PEDESTRIANS & CYCLISTS REJOICE!

**A Model Walking and Cycling Town**  
Enhanced connectivity with cycling network to be extended to about 21km. By 2020, 4km of cycling paths are expected to be completed, with the rest of the network to be completed by 2022. Footpaths will be widened, and safety signs and markings will be implemented along the cycling paths to make walking and cycling safer and more convenient.

To support the growth of Tampines as a regional employment centre in the east, there will be cycling path networks between Tampines and neighbouring towns such as Pasir Ris and Simei, as well as to the Changi Business Park and Singapore Expo. The Land Transport Authority (LTA) is studying the feasibility of building a cycling bridge over the Tampines Expressway (TPE) to connect Tampines and Pasir Ris towns, as well as a cycling underpass to link Tampines and Simei.

# BRINGING NATURE CLOSER TO EVERYONE

## Enhancing the Park Connector Network

New park connectors along Tampines Avenue 9 and 10 will link the Boulevard Park to the existing Bedok Reservoir Park. In addition, sections of existing park connectors will be enhanced to improve the user experience. The tracks will be resurfaced, lighting improved and amenities installed for the benefit of residents.



## Enhanced Streetscape to Bring Nature to Your Doorstep

Come 2022, residents can have a more enjoyable commute with verdant greenery along main entryways and at the vicinity of transport hubs. Covered linkways will be enhanced with attractive flowering climbers, while along roadsides, Nature Ways with their tiered planting will provide a sense of being amidst an urban forest. Tiered planting mimics forest ecosystems and includes species of plants that attract birds and butterflies, thereby bringing residents closer to nature.

## New Boulevard Park

Residents can look forward to the opening of the new Boulevard Park in 2022. Adjacent to Tampines Eco Green, the 13-hectare park will provide more recreational opportunities for residents. For example, young ones can explore and develop their sense of discovery at the Nature Playgarden, and those wanting to keep fit can run and use the fitness equipment in a park setting and ambience.







# ACTIVE, BEAUTIFUL, CLEAN WATERS

## ABC Waters Programme @ Sungei Tampines

A 1.4-kilometre stretch of Sungei Tampines between Tampines Avenue 7 and the Tampines Expressway will be enhanced alongside drainage improvement works to increase drainage capacity and provide a better experience for residents and park users.

The project is expected to be completed by the 4th quarter of 2021.

TRANSFORMING TAMPINES INTO AN ECO TOWN

A CIRCULAR ZERO WASTE SYSTEM

As part of our sustainability efforts, Tampines is committed to reducing waste and retaining soil moisture through the system of circular economy.

**An example of such a project:**  
Our horticultural team collects the natural by-products of trees (such as branches, leaves etc.) and puts it through a wood chipping machine. This produces compost which can be used to enrich the soil. The soil will be used to provide more nutrients to the trees in our estate.



TRANSFORMING TAMPINES INTO AN ECO TOWN

SUSTAINABILITY @ TAMPINES PARK

Tampines Park will soon be home to two new urban farms!

A vertical vegetable farm will be set up at Block 146, while the existing pond in Tampines Park will be converted into a fish farm rearing tilapia.

Tampines Park will be the first precinct to host Singapore's first community-based circular ecosystem for food production.

Not only will this project reduce food waste, it will simultaneously strengthen the community's food resilience!



- HOW WILL IT WORK?
- 1 Food waste from residents will be collected and fed to Black Soldier Fly (BSF) larvae, a type of decomposer.
  - 2 The nutrition-packed BSF larvae will be processed and fed to the fish, while the excreta (frass) from the larvae will be used to fertilise vegetables in the vertical farm.
  - 3 The vegetables and tilapia will then be harvested, completing the cycle.

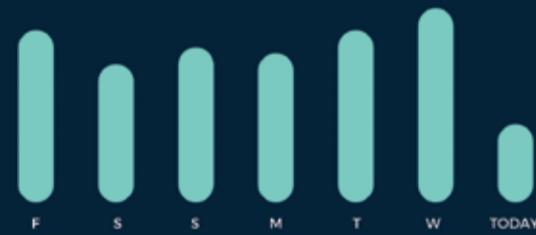

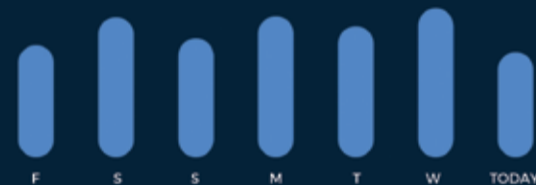

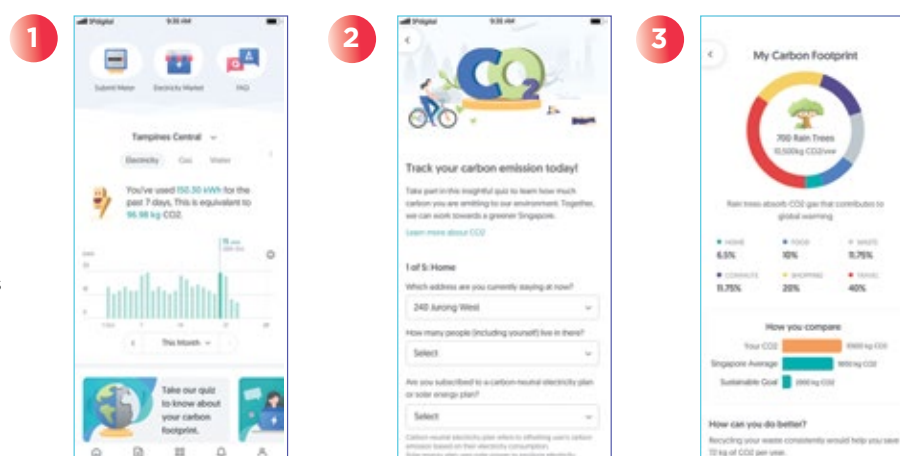
## AI-ENABLED, ECO-FRIENDLY SMART ENERGY SYSTEM

As part of our efforts to transform Tampines into an Eco Town, the Ministry of the Environment and Water Resources (MEWR), Temasek and SP Group are collaborating to install Eco Boards across several HDB blocks. The Eco Boards are low-energy digital displays which enable residents to be more aware of their impact on the environment.

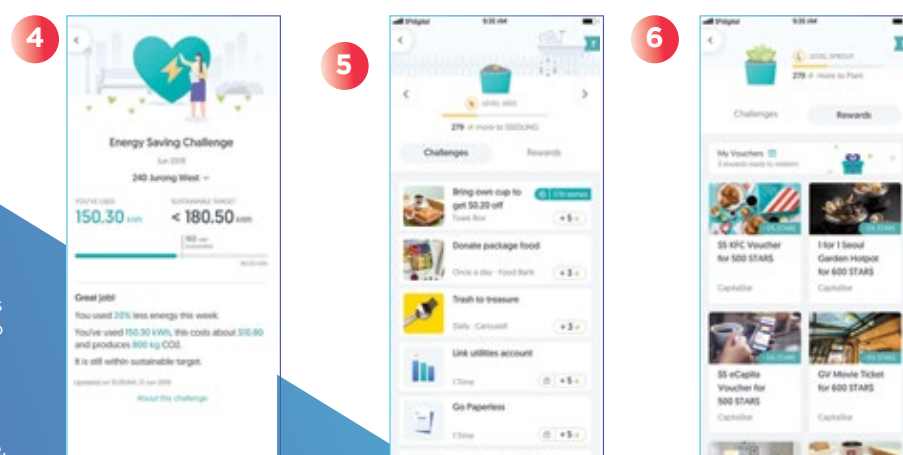
Installed at lift lobbies, residents will get updates of their water and electricity consumption, and the amount of carbon emissions at each block. The boards will also provide residents with green tips on how to lower their electricity and water consumption. Block-level challenges will also be introduced through the boards to spur residents' adoption of a more sustainable lifestyle.

The Eco Boards will also help the Town Council to be more resource-efficient through greater awareness of the estate's utilities consumption, and to reduce wastage.

**1, 2 and 3:** Residents can find out their personal carbon footprint through a questionnaire and by monitoring their electricity consumption.



**4, 5 and 6:** Residents can also learn how to reduce their carbon emissions, and be rewarded for their green actions in the GreenUp programme.

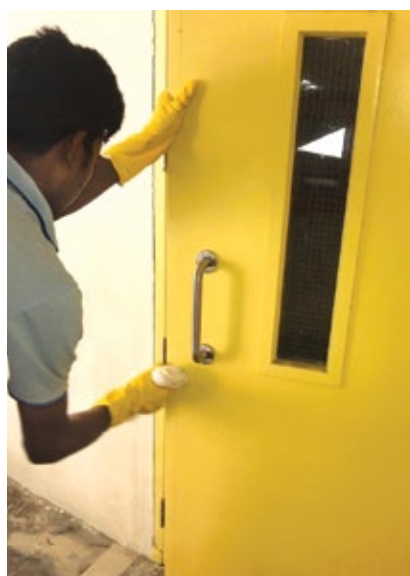

# BEATING COVID-19 WITH CARE AND CLEANLINESS



Tampines Town Council responded quickly to the outbreak of COVID-19 and protocols were put in place to keep our shared spaces clean and safe for all residents. Frequently touched areas such as lift buttons, handrails, and letter boxes are cleaned and sanitised twice daily while playgrounds and fitness corners are cleaned and sanitised once a day.

The Town Council Office also stepped up on precautionary measures to protect its staff and residents. A counter has been set up for all visitors to take their body temperature and sanitise their hands. Those who are unwell are advised to visit a doctor immediately. Daily body temperature screening has been implemented among all staff too.

When there were reports of COVID-19 cases, our Chairman Ms Cheng Li Hui oversaw the swift sanitisation of affected areas by the Town Council and the National Environment Agency (NEA). Ms Cheng also visited the affected families and provided them with the CC's contact details in case they needed assistance. To lighten their spirits, she left some food and necessities at the door for them.

Our MPs have been working on the ground to reassure affected residents that the situation is under control. However, residents should not let their guard down and continue to maintain good personal hygiene.

# Sew Love SG

Our Chairman Ms Cheng Li Hui started the support group Sew Love SG to gather volunteers to help produce masks for our children and migrant workers. With everyone's united effort, we have produced more than 30,000 masks for schools, hospitals, dormitories and shelters. In our battle against COVID-19, we have witnessed compassion and solidarity. The spirit of SG United is stronger than ever!



## TAMPINES SUPPORTS SG CLEAN

The SG Clean campaign was launched nationwide in February 2020. The movement calls on the public and food stall operators to maintain cleanliness at public spaces. Tampines Town Council supported the campaign by sharing its vision with operators to have all coffeeshops and eating places in Tampines to be certified "SG Clean". In addition to adhering to sanitation and hygiene checklists, the Town Council produced a series of print, video and social media campaigns to create greater awareness of good personal hygiene practices, and instil a more collaborative approach in keeping our shared spaces clean beyond the current outbreak of COVID-19.

## Singapore Budget 2020: S&CC Rebate from the Care & Support Package

The Care and Support Package announced by Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Finance, Mr Heng Swee Keat, during Budget 2020 will help Singaporean households with their living expenses. Under this package, eligible Singaporean households living in HDB flats receive rebates amounting to 1.5 to 3.5 months of Service and Conservancy Charges (S&CC).

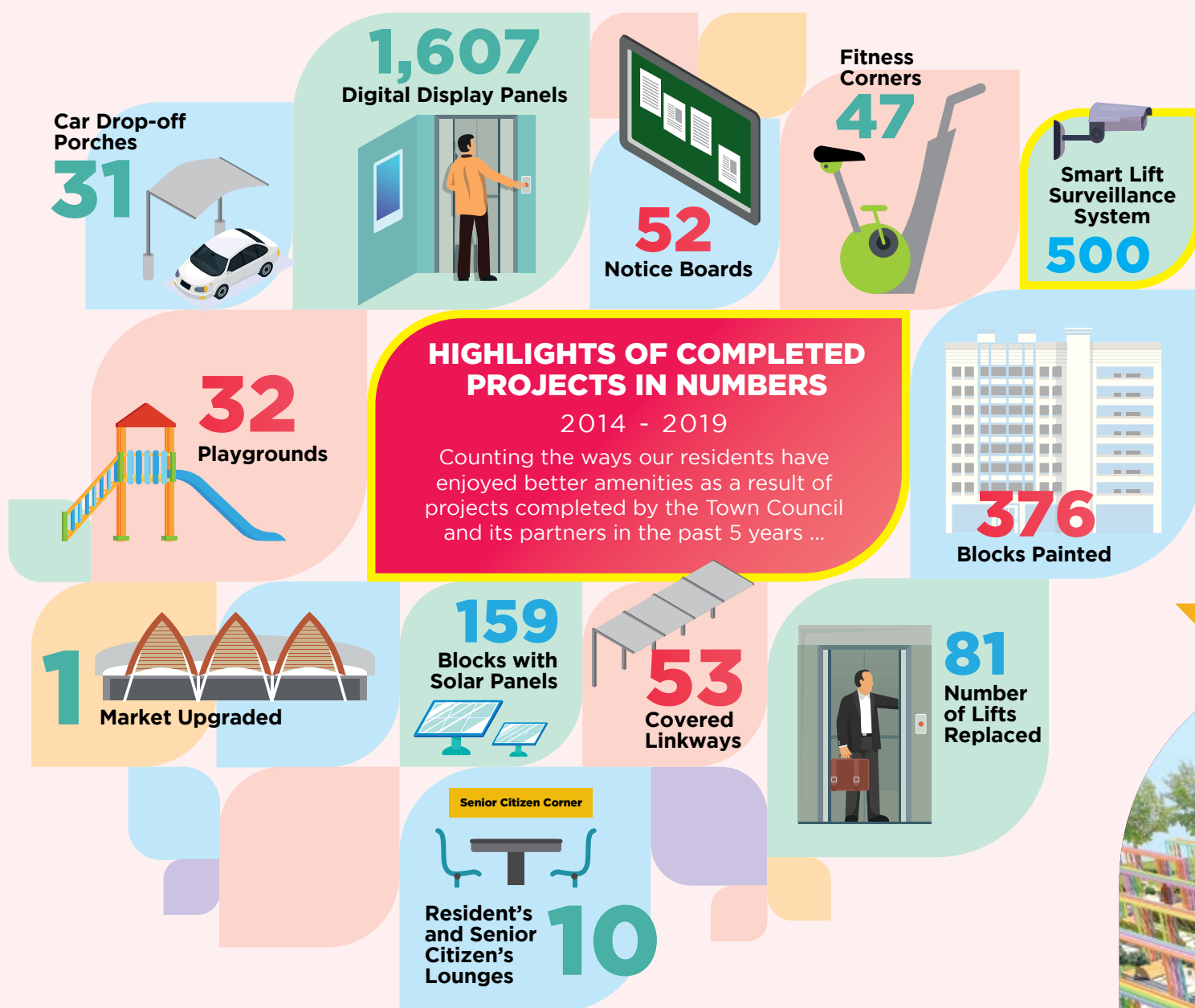
