

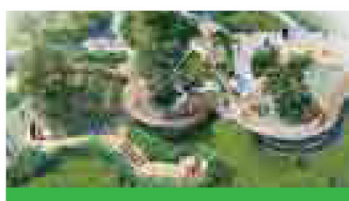

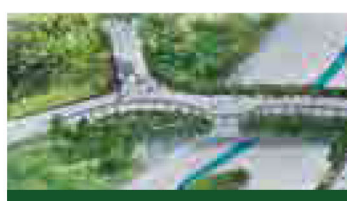

Introducing Our New Parks

Residents can look forward to four brand new major parks that will be built or transformed as part of the Our Tampines in a Garden project. The sprawling **Tampines Boulevard Park**, a major project in partnership with National Parks Board (NParks) due to open by 2022, will be a one-of-its-kind play-cum-fitness nature hub that families of all ages can enjoy. The new **ABC Waters @ Sungei Tampines**, slated to open by 2nd quarter of 2022 in collaboration with the Public Utilities Board (PUB), will feature a naturalised slope and ABC Waters design features such as lookout decks with views of the rejuvenated waterway. Residents can look forward to upgrading works in **Tampines Eco Green**, which will be unveiled in 2022.

Tampines: A Garden Town Like No Other

Our Tampines in a Garden (OTG) is Tampines' first major community programme under the "Tampines Together: Building Our Eco-Town 2025" project. The vision we have for all Tampines residents is for everyone to have access to a park or park facilities within a 10-minute walk from their home, regardless of where they stay in town. We want to build Tampines into a true "Garden Town"!

Collaborating with lead government authorities like the National Environment Agency (NEA), NParks, PUB and Ministry of Sustainability and the Environment (MSE), residents can look forward to a variety of facelift and enhancement projects to transform our existing parks, as well as welcoming two new parks, which will be rolled out over the next two years.

Holistically designed, with particular attention paid to catering to every resident's specific needs, our new garden network will feature a host of new nature experiences, from forest trails

and sanctuary corners to children-centric community spaces and play areas to therapeutic gardens that uplift mental well-being and state-of-the-art digital elements, weaved in our midst.

When fully complete, our green network will evoke our five senses of sight, smell, sound, taste and touch like never before, right at our own doorstep. There's just so much more to look forward to when it all happens!

A True Walking, Cycling Town with Gardens in Our Midst

As Singapore's first town to have its own cycling network, we are proud that Tampines is already well regarded as a cycling town.

Our efforts to enhance connectivity are ongoing. Footpaths will be widened, and safety signs and markings will be implemented along cycling paths to make walking and cycling safer and more convenient.

Residents will be able to walk and cycle longer, and more safely and conveniently, to and from their homes!



Connected by Our Passion for Green

Our Tampines in a Garden is not just about parks — it is about planning out an intricately linked, seamless network of greenery that will adorn our neighbourhoods, our estates, our homes. It is about bringing nature closer to everyone.

Our current Tampines Park Connector links Bedok Reservoir Park to Pasir Ris Park, running along housing estates in Tampines Avenue 1 and 2, allowing users to travel to Pasir Ris Town Park via Sungei Tampines.

The Tampines Park Connector also runs under the viaduct of Tampines and Simei MRT stations, allowing park users to travel to Simei estate easily.

With new park connectors planned along Tampines Avenue 9 and 10, we will see the new Tampines Boulevard Park linked directly to Bedok Reservoir Park. These new connectors will feature new additions such as improved lighting, enhanced amenities and new resurfacing technology.

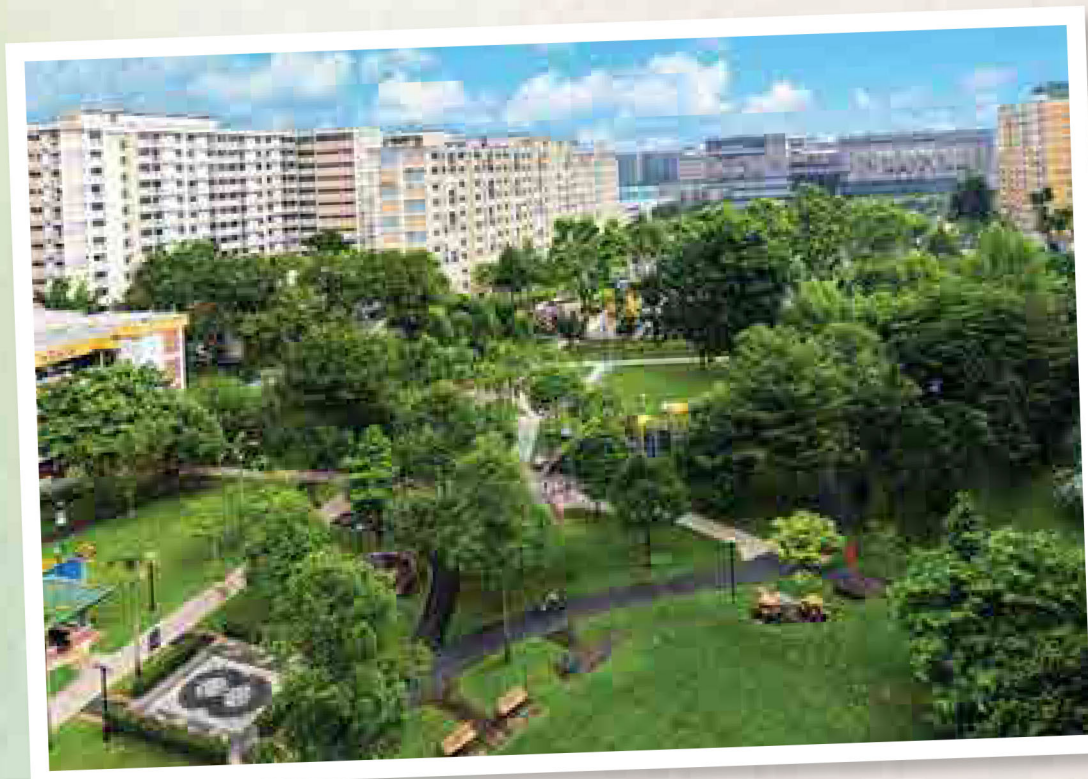

Tampines Streetscapes – Bringing Nature One Step Closer to Your Doorstep

A vital consideration in any town planning project in Singapore is the amount of greenery throughout the estate. Tampines residents will be able to enjoy an unparalleled commuting experience surrounded by greenery by 2023, where verdant streetscapes will be a prominent feature along major entryways and in the vicinity of transport hubs.

Covered linkways will be enhanced with attractive flowering climbers, while tiered planting that reminds people of forest ecosystems will be curated along roadsides. Many species of plants introduced will attract birds and butterflies, and residents can look forward to being one step closer to nature in the midst of their commute.

Something for Every Resident

Adjacent to Tampines Eco Green, the new 13-hectare **Tampines Boulevard Park**, to be launched by 2022, will focus on providing a suite of personalised, inclusive recreational amenities for residents' well-being.

Young ones can look forward to exploring and developing their sense of discovery through the Nature Playgarden, while those wanting to keep fit can run and use fitness equipment available at the park.

Holistically designed, residents can expect truly new and innovative features like a skate corner, dog run area, and inclusive facilities for residents with special needs.

When open, there will be something for all residents to use and enjoy!

Smart & Eco-Sustainable Features

The park is designed with smart and eco-sustainable features, including lamp posts powered with solar panels, efficient LED light fittings, recycled wood logs for park furniture, and green roof shelters.

Nature Playgarden

The Nature Playgarden is in an environment where children can connect with nature while playing and exploring in a natural habitat. Other features include a High-Intensity Fitness Corner with fitness machines and a running track, a pavilion with an open deck for tai-chi and yoga, a 3G Fitness Corner with more inclusive fitness equipment, and Allotment Gardens that enable residents to grow their own plants.

Tampines Boulevard Park will open by 2022.

ABC Waters @ Sungei Tampines:

Active, Beautiful and Clean in Our Town

Tampines residents will be able to enjoy views of the rejuvenated **Sungei Tampines**. This 1.4km stretch of waterway between Tampines Ave 9 and the TPE is expected to be completed by 2nd quarter 2022.

Sanctuary at Your Doorstep

Bringing nature closer to Tampines residents, the project will feature, amongst other added amenities, new lookout decks, a rain garden, naturalised river bank, garden bridge, footpaths and more.



Close to a Naturalised Waterway

Lookout decks along the naturalised waterway provide vantage points for residents to enjoy views of the waterway up close. There are also recreational spaces created around the waters to inspire residents to have more appreciation for our water resources and to keep them clean.



Tampines Eco Green:

Our Very Own Ecological Wonderland

Tucked away in the Tampines heartland between Tampines Avenue 9 and Tampines Avenue 12 is **Tampines Eco Green**, a 36.5-hectare ecological park that resembles a savannah with marshlands, secondary forests and freshwater ponds.

The green sanctuary is home to over 75 species of birds, 20 species of dragonflies, 35 species of butterflies and 32 species of spiders.

This ecological park includes features like an eco-toilet, vegetated swales, bird hides and green roofs on all the shelters. Even the park furniture was made using recycled materials and environmentally-friendly products. Tampines Eco Green currently has three trails, offering residents opportunities to experience nature up close while they walk or exercise on the green, gentle terrain.



Biodiversity in Nature

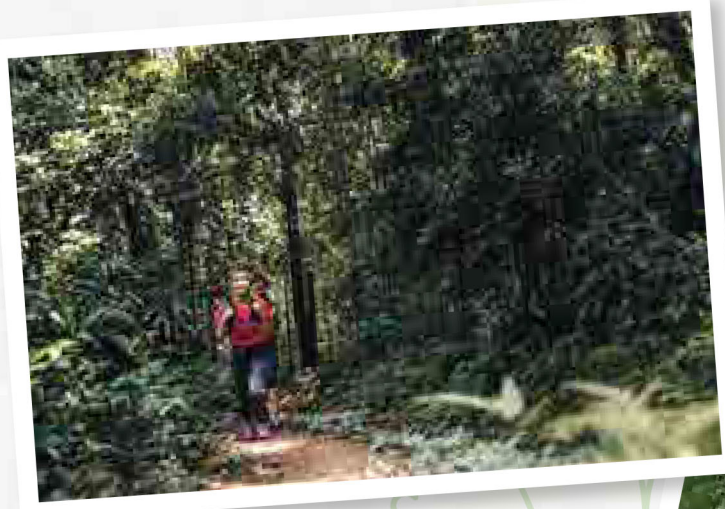
With various natural habitats, such as open grasslands, freshwater wetlands and a secondary rainforest, the Tampines Eco Green is a haven for biodiversity and a great place for visitors to enjoy the best of nature.

With features like vegetated swales, bird hides and green roofs on all the shelters, the park offers a diverse and intriguing ecosystem experience for visitors and enthusiasts alike.



Rustic Trails at Your Doorstep

The park's three trails, **Diversity Trail**, **Forest Trail** and **Marsh Trail**, weave through secondary forests, allowing nature lovers and wildlife photographers access to nature up close. You never know what to expect on one of these trails until you try it!



Marsh Trail

At a mere 0.8km, Marsh Trail is the shortest trail in the park but with enough of a rustic experience



Forest Trail

This breezy 1km trail allows trekkers an easy start to their nature adventure



Diversity Trail

Stretching 1.2km, the Diversity Trail offers a moderately easy walk, with the possibility of spotting bird-watching hides made out of twigs and branches
