Para penduduk Tampines yang dihormati,

Tampines, bersama kita telah menempuh perjalanan yang jauh.

Daripada sebuah perkampungan pertanian yang serba sederhana, Tampines telah bertukar menjadi salah satu bandar yang paling menarik dan moden di Singapura. Malah, Tampines tidak pernah berhenti berkembang untuk memenuhi keperluan penduduknya yang sentiasa berubah.

Selama bertahun-tahun, para penduduknya telah menikmati banyak pembangunan yang meningkatkan mutu hidup mereka. Kita mempunyai kemudahan yang lebih baik (ya, kita tidak berpuas hati dengan mempunyai setakat satu stesen MRT, malah kita menambah tiga lagi) dan merintis teknologi paling canggih (kita merupakan bandar pertama yang menternak ikan dan membiak lalat askar hitam untuk mengitar semula sisa makanan) demi melindungi generasi yang akan datang daripada kesan perubahan iklim.

Pertumbuhan besar yang dialami Tampines tidak mungkin menjadi kenyataan tanpa sokongan anda para penduduk kita. Itulah sebabnya kami sentiasa mengutamakan keperluan para penduduk kita dalam setiap perancangan kami. Kami mengalu-alukan maklum balas penduduk dan menggalakkan mereka supaya turut serta dalam pelbagai program masyarakat. ஒரு எளிய பண்ணையாக இருந்து இன்று சிங்கப்பூரின் மிகவும் துடிப்பான மற்றும் நவீன நகரங்களில் ஒன்றாக மாறியது. தெம்பனிஸ் எப்போதும் அதன் குடியிருப்பாளர்களின் தேவைகளைப் பூர்த்தி செய்வதை நிறுத்தவில்லை.

குடியிருப்பாளர்கள் தங்கள் வாழ்க்கைத் தரத்தை மேம்படுத்தும் பல முன்னேற்றங்களை பல ஆண்டுகளாக அனுபவித்து வந்துள்ளனர். காலத்தின் மாற்றத்திலிருந்து எதிர்கால சந்ததியனரைப் பாதுகாக்க எங்களிடம் சிறந்த வசதிகள் மற்றும் அதிநவீன தொழில்நுட்பங்கள் உள்ளன. (ஆம். நாங்கள் ஒரு பெருவிரைவு போக்குவரத்து ரயில் நிலையத்தால் திருப்தி அடையவில்லை ஆதலால் மேலும் மூன்றிணை இணைத்தோம்). 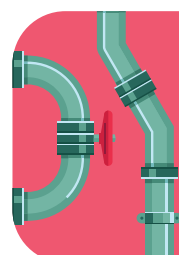


Pneumatic Waste Conveyance System

Connected Parks Catering To All Ages

The soon-to-be completed Boulevard Park and the new ABC Waters @ Sungei Tampines are connected to Tampines Eco Green and Sun Plaza Park via park connectors and the Tampines Biking Trail.

Residents can enjoy vast areas of green spaces that have amenities catering to all ages.



FOR FAMILIES

The sprawling 13-hectare Tampines Boulevard Park, due to open by 2024, will be a one-of-its-kind play-cum-fitness nature hub that families of all ages can enjoy. There are amenities such as a children's Nature Playgarden, fitness corners, and facilities for people with special needs.



FOR NATURE LOVERS

The 36.5-hectare Tampines Eco Green is a nature lover's haven. It resembles a savannah with marshlands, secondary forests, and freshwater ponds — making it a green sanctuary for many species of birds, insects, fauna, and flora.



FOR SENIORS

Sun Plaza Park has a new therapeutic garden that is accessible to wheelchair users who can enjoy the fragrant and edible plants. Children and the elderly visit the bead maze that helps improve their hand-eye coordination.



FOR FAMILIES

The new 1.4-kilometre waterway ABC Waters at Sungei Tampines has new recreation and community spaces and enhanced connectivity to Tampines Eco Green. Residents can enjoy views of the greenery on the naturalised slope, lookout decks, garden bridge, and rain garden.

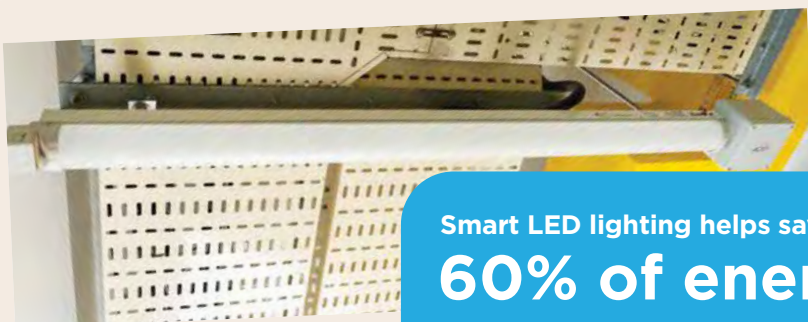

Blocks in Tampines GreenVines are installed with the latest smart lighting technology. More blocks will install the same system progressively.

160 Solar Panels

Solar energy is harnessed to power common services (e.g. lifts, lights and water pumps) of HDB blocks in the day. By 2025, Tampines will generate enough solar energy to power the equivalent of **7,000** four-room HDB flats.



Project Wolbachia

Tampines is one of the first towns to pilot Project Wolbachia. Covering the entire Tampines, Project Wolbachia has been effective in reducing the *Aedes Aegypti* mosquito population.

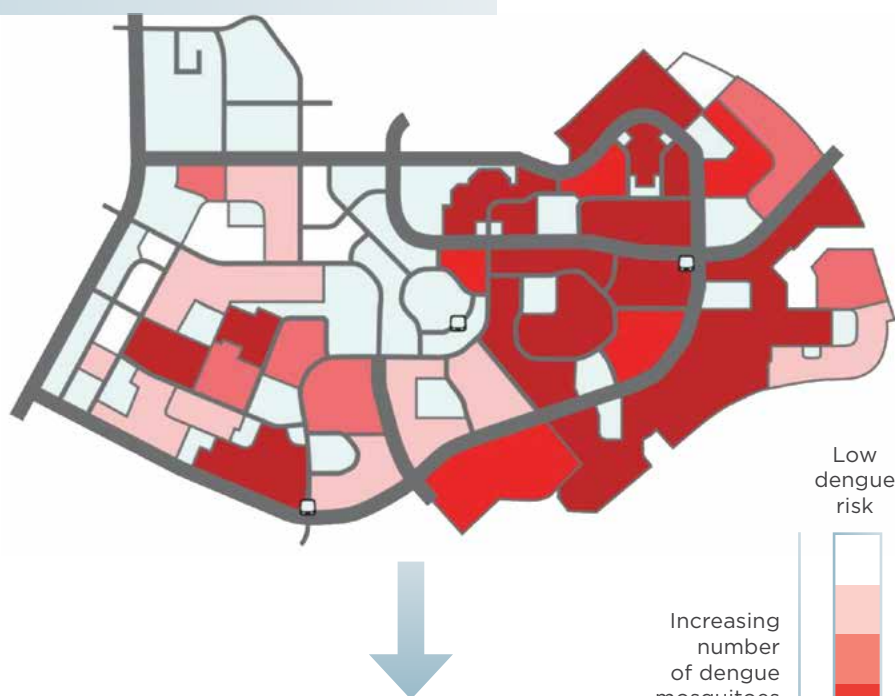

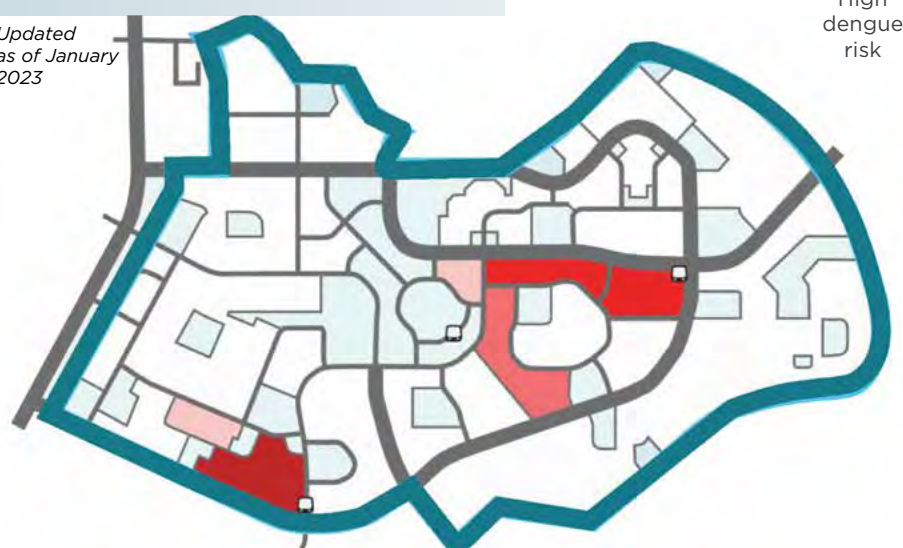

A Fridge That's Filled With Love

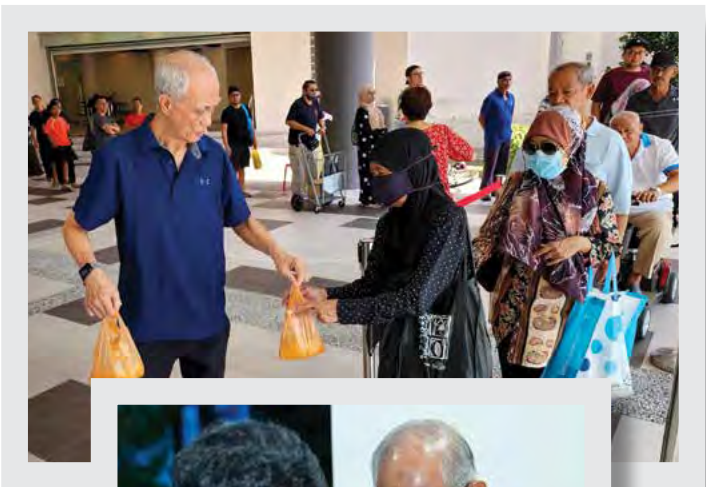

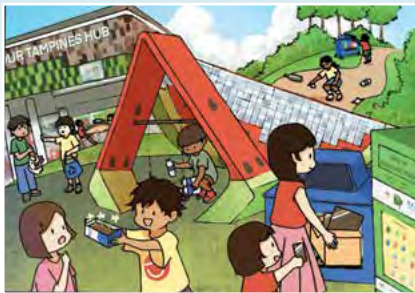

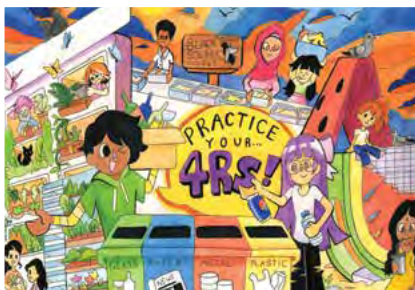
